

## History

On April 6 1920 a petition was drawn up to build a school in the district. A meeting was held on April 24 1920 at John Boychuks with the first trustees. After the 2 acres of land was purchased the name Brookview was suggested because of a small trickling creek on the SE corner of the land. Tenders were called to build the school and on April 16 1921 they accepted Warner Soderlunds tender for \$1920.00. The first day of school was August 7 1922 with 64 children registering. In 38 years of Brookview History 332 pupils attended school. Since 1922 there have been 31 teachers. The school closed in June 1960 because of reduction in enrollment. There were only 21 students from grades 1-8 at the time.

August 10, 2016 Brookview School was moved from its country location to its new home at the Sturgis Station House Museum in Sturgis by Aaron Bartch Building Movers Inc. Restoration began and was completed in 2019
